*Albemarle County Schools District Wide Classroom Revitalization Project*

**Description of Work:**

*Albemarle County Schools began an initiative to revitalize all of their classroom spaces modernizing each space to allow for a 21<sup>st</sup> century learning environment. Key emphasis was placed on ergonomic, flexible furniture designed with student comfort and product reconfigurability in mind. A minimum of three different seating options as well as a standing option are included in each space to allow for student seating choice. Soft furniture, mobile, reconfigurable deskings, as well as flexible storage pieces are all utilized to allow for maximum flexibility and choice. Over the past three years, we have modernized classrooms in all 15 elementary schools, all 6 middle schools, and all 4 high schools.*
